

ULTIMATE CRYSTAL RIVER MANATEE SNORKELING CHECKLIST

Before You Go:	
	Confirm Your Tour Reservation : Contact your chosen guide center to confirm your booking details, including the date, time, and any special instructions they might have for your manatee snorkeling tour.
	Check Equipment Provided : While most tours offer snorkeling gear and wetsuits, it's best to verify what's included. Ask if there are items you should bring that aren't covered.
	Understand the Rules : Familiarize yourself with the guidelines for interacting with manatees. Your guide center will provide instructions on how to behave to ensure a respectful experience for both you and the manatees.
What to Bring:	
	Eco-Friendly Sunscreen : Opt for reef-safe sunscreen to protect your skin while minimizing impact on the marine ecosystem.
	Personal Snorkeling Gear : If you prefer using your own equipment, consider bringing a mask, snorkel, and fins. Ensure they are in good condition and fit well for the best experience.
	Wetsuit for Warmth and Buoyancy : Check if your tour provider supplies wetsuits. If not or if you prefer your own, bring one along to stay warm in the cooler spring waters.
	Waterproof Camera or GoPro : Document your encounter without disturbing the manatees. Make sure it's fully charged and has enough memory space.
	Towels and a Change of Clothes : You'll want to dry off and change into warm clothes after your snorkeling session.
	Reusable Water Bottle : Stay hydrated with a water bottle that can be refilled, reducing plastic waste.
	Snacks : Bring light, eco-friendly snacks to keep your energy up, especially for tours that last several hours.
	Cash for Tips : Having cash on hand allows you to tip your guide or boat captain for their expertise and service if they did a good job. (And in our small town of Inglis, Yankeetown, and Crystal River, they always do)
